

FACIAL COVERING FOR INFECTION CONTROL

The facility may choose to require Visitors and Staff to adhere to source control measures including the use of face coverings to prevent the spread of respiratory infections in accordance with the standards recommended by the CDC, under any of the following situations:

- 1. When the facility is experiencing an outbreak of SARS-COV-2 infection or other respiratory infections.**
- 2. When visiting/taking care of a resident who is exhibiting signs and symptoms of an infectious disease that can be spread through droplet or airborne transmission.**
- 3. When visiting/taking care of a resident who is immunocompromised and the treating practitioner has determined the use of facial covering is necessary for the resident's protection**
- 4. Who had closer contact with someone with SARS-COV-2 infection for the last 10 days.**
- 5. As recommended by public health authorities**
